Education Technology Work Group Overview

The Education Technology Work Group will be responsible for creating content for the newly redesigned/redeveloped MyATLS mobile app (initially), anticipated launch December 2023. Members will connect with the content leads on the ATLS 11th Edition Revision project to determine the most appropriate content for the mobile app. They will also participate in ongoing case scenario development, writing and revising of MCQs (multiple-choice quiz questions), and flashcards for the gaming aspect of the mobile app. The COT is working with a vendor to do the full design and development of the MyATLS mobile app.

It is critical that the content for the mobile app represents a global perspective.

Education Technology Work Group Deliverable(s)

- Create initial content for Version 1.0 and ongoing content to be released monthly
 - Goal of minimum of 3-6 months of content prior to launch
- Curriculum to be relevant and applicable to a variety of environments, mechanisms of injury, and resource availability
- Include a focus on diversity, equity, and inclusion to ensure curriculum is effective in its delivery to the global community
- Future endeavors may include reviewing new technologies for COT Education and/or creating content for additional COT mobile apps

The Education Technology Work Group will be comprised of representatives from the COT Education target audience (e.g., trauma surgeons, ER physicians, family practice physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, other advanced practice providers, etc.).

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
