



AEI Standards and Criteria for Accreditation Overview of 2021 Revisions

The goals of the 2021 revisions were to reduce redundancy and clarify intent. This resulted in what is primarily a reorganization of the current Standards. Please use this document as a quick reference and orientation to the revisions.

Summary of Changes:

- While there aren't any new Standards per say, the original Standards were reorganized which resulted in five Standards as opposed to four.
- Only one new Criterion has been added – Criterion 5.2: Annual Compliance Reports.
- Minor changes were made to most Criteria. In some instances, the documentation required to demonstrate compliance was also changed. The required documentation is now stated in the Standards Manual.
- Requirements for Comprehensive and Focused accreditation are now incorporated into one set of Standards. The differences in the requirements are noted in the language.

<p>Criterion 3.2.2: Education Institute Surgical Director</p>	<p>Criterion 1.2: Education Institute Surgical Director</p> <p>Removed the following requirements: The Education Institute Surgical Director must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate a commitment to surgical education • Be responsible for reporting to the Steering Committee or Advisory Board assessment data related to the surgical education and training programs of the AEI <p>Added language:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Former AEI Simulation Fellows with Associate FACS designation are eligible to serve as the Surgical Director.
<p>Criterion 3.2.3: Administrative and Support Staff</p>	<p>Criterion 1.3: Administrative and Support Staff</p> <p>Removed the following requirements: Administrative and support staff perform the following duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Serving as a liaison between the Institute's Director and outside entities • Ordering supplies • Acquisition of the assessment data related to Criterion 2.3 • Conduct ongoing inventories of supplies, simulators, equipment, and make recommendations for the acquisition of new supplies • Organize resources • Ensure the safe operation of the AEI through appropriate use of safety and policies & procedures manuals • Set-up and take-down of skills stations as required <p>Added a requirement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administrative and support staff are responsible for daily operations of the simulation center <p>Edited language:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administrative and support staff assist with preparation and documentation of CME activities for courses and participants (when offered)

<p>Criterion 3.3: Device Inventory</p>	<p>Criterion 3.4: Device Inventory</p> <p>Added language: Education Institutes must list the necessary devices for their existing and planned curricula and have the support to use them effectively to meet their learners' and curricular needs.</p>
<p>Criterion 3.4: Financial Resources</p>	<p>Criterion 2.2: Ongoing Financial Resources and Support</p> <p>Renamed Criterion and added language:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Budget deficits of 25% or more must be explained and supported in the document and tables.
<p>Criterion 3.5: Mission Statement</p>	<p>Criterion 2.1: Statement of Purpose</p> <p>Now refer to mission statement as “statement of purpose.”</p>
<p>Criterion 3.6: Steering Committee or Advisory Board</p>	<p>Criterion 2.3: AEI Oversight Committee</p> <p>Now refer to “Steering Committee” and Advisory Board” to “AEI Oversight Committee.”</p> <p>Added three requirements: The AEI Oversight Committee:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintains authority over the curricula offerings by managing, supervising, monitoring, modifying, and adding curricula to meet the needs of learners • Reviews ACS accreditation requirements and determines if the Standards are continuously being met by all entities participating/using the simulation center. • Meets at least twice each calendar year. Minutes must document each meeting.
<p>Criterion 3.7: Organizational Structure</p>	<p>Criterion 2.4: Organizational Structure</p> <p>Now references the AEI Oversight Committee instead of the Steering Committee/Advisory Board as described in Criterion 2.3.</p>

<p>Criterion 4.1: Research or Scholarly Activities in Simulation-Based Education</p>	<p>Criterion 5.1: Research or Scholarly Activities in Simulation-Based Education</p> <p>No changes. Still not applicable for Focused Institutes.</p>
<p>Criterion 4.2: Involvement in the Consortium of ACS-accredited Education Institutes</p>	<p>Criterion 5.3: Involvement in the Consortium of ACS-accredited Education Institutes</p> <p>Moved the requirement of annual reports to its own Criterion – Criterion 5.2 – otherwise no changes.</p>
<p>N/A – new Criterion, not in original Standards</p>	<p>Criterion 5.2: Annual Compliance Reports</p> <p>Added this Criterion which asks AElS to attest to completing the annual compliance report during each year of its accreditation term.</p>
