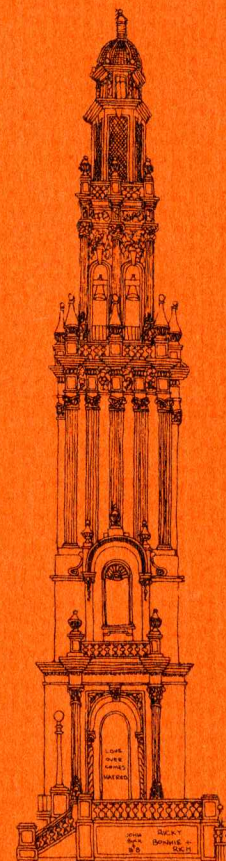

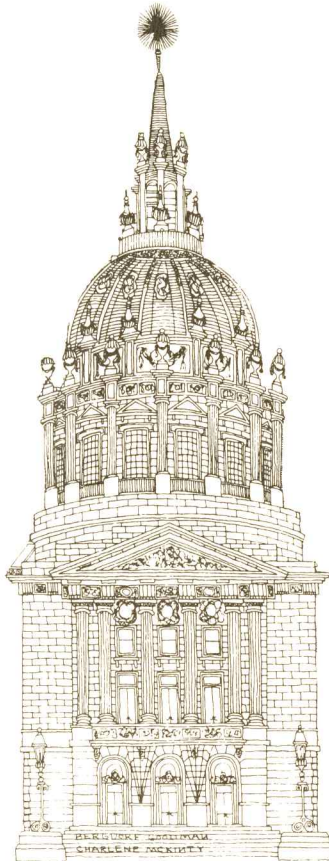

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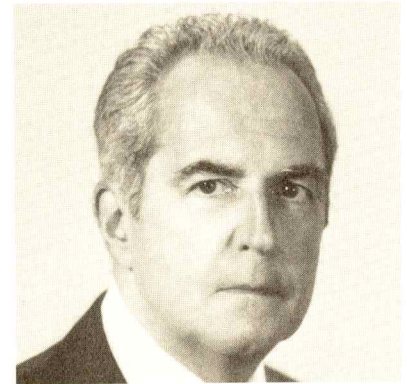

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The President, 1975-76 American College of Surgeons



Henry William Scott, Jr., exemplifies what an era less convinced than ours of the merits of exclusive specialization might have called "a surgeon par excellence." Drive, talent, fortuitous circumstances, sheer luck, a penchant for perfectionism, and, above all, an uncompromising devotion to his profession are the ingredients that account for the career and accomplishments of the 56th President of the American College of Surgeons.

After a boyhood "spent fooling with radios," Dr. Scott had planned a career in engineering, but he changed his mind suddenly when, at a prep school football game, he watched a cousin of his, a physician, give first aid to an injured player. That act embodied for him everything he considered worthwhile in a career: manual skill, knowledge, humanistic concern. After earning an A.B. degree at the University of North Carolina, he left his native state and enrolled at Harvard Medical School. "Most students," he recalls, "apply to at least four medical schools. I must have had an incredible combination of conceit and naiveté to apply



only at Harvard. At any rate, despite my credentials they accepted me." After graduation in 1941 he remained in Boston where he served as intern in pathology and intern in surgery, and as surgical resident at the Peter Bent Brigham Hospital and The Children's Hospital. An active duodenal ulcer kept him out of the military service. In 1945 he became a Harvey Cushing Fellow in Neurosurgery at Brigham and Children's Hospital and the next year accepted a surgical residency at The Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore. Here he came under the tutelage of Dr. Alfred Blalock who had come to Johns Hopkins after having spent 16 years at Vanderbilt University.

"When I left Boston to go to Johns Hopkins I was lucky again to be in the right place at the right time. Working with Dr. Blalock, who was then making medical history with the 'blue baby' operation, was much more than an educationally profitable experience—it was an experience that made me set my own goals and standards as a surgeon." It was at Johns Hopkins, also, that Dr. Scott participated in the first operation ever performed on closed circuit television.

Academic appointments at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, and clinical assignments at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, filled the years from 1946 to 1952, when Dr. Scott assumed his present position as professor of surgery and chairman of the department at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine in Nashville, and as surgeon-in-chief of the Vanderbilt Hospital.

Dr. Scott's tenure at Vanderbilt has been eminently successful, no matter what criteria one applies in measuring the success of a surgical department. As an educator, he can point to the superior scoring of his students

on the examinations of the National Board of Medical Examiners. As an administrator, he can point to the impressive growth of his department. When he took over the department, it had few beds, scant funds, and an approved residency only in general surgery. There were no residencies in plastic surgery, urology, orthopedics, thoracic and cardiac surgery, neurosurgery, oral surgery or ophthalmology. Today these services are flourishing; there are 485 surgical beds in the Vanderbilt University affiliated hospitals and departmental programs have attracted some of the ablest surgeons in the country to this department. Finally—although this may be first in the order of things to which this general surgeon feels himself most strongly attracted—he has made his department a focal point of surgical research. His own research work has dealt chiefly with the surgical aspects of cardiovascular diseases, with experimental atherosclerosis, endocrinology, and surgical therapy for peptic ulcer. The scope of his interest in surgical research is reflected in the more

than 250 articles he has written on a wide variety of subjects, and has found acknowledgement by the surgical research community in his serving as chairman of the Surgical Study Section at National Institutes of Health and in his election to the chairmanship of the ACS Committee on the Forum on Fundamental Surgical Problems, a position he held from 1965-1968.

The chairmanship of the Forum Committee was but one of Dr. Scott's commitments to the affairs of the College. A Fellow since 1950, he was a Governor from 1963-1967, and treasurer of the College from 1967-1972, an office he relinquished when he became a Regent. By assuming the presidency of the College, Dr. Scott may add a new task but not an altogether unfamiliar experience to his commitments. He has held the presidency of the American Surgical Association, the Halsted Society, The Nashville Surgical Society, the Society of Clinical Surgery, the Society for Surgery of the

Alimentary Tract, the Society of University Surgeons, and the Tennessee Chapter of the American College of Surgeons. Besides, he has held office in, or is a member or honorary member of, more than 30 other professional societies. When his wife's alma mater sent out a questionnaire about the clubs to which the husbands of the alumnae belonged, Mary Scott simply had a list typed which she returned with the notation, "You asked for it."

Whatever in Bill Scott's life remains unclaimed by his profession belongs to his wife, a Vassar graduate, and his four children, a son and three daughters. The tennis court behind their house is especially popular with the Scott family. Here Dr. Scott finds relaxation after the day's tensions and frustrations. In the grudgingly admiring judgment of his students he may be an "old bear," but, according to his wife's testimony, the 59-year-old surgeon is still capable of "whamming that tennis ball for all it's worth."

I further promise to make my fees commensurate with the services rendered and with the patient's rights. Moreover, I promise to deal with each patient as I would wish to be dealt with were I in his position.

Finally, I pledge myself to cooperate in advancing and extending the ideals and principles of the American College of Surgeons.
