## PENNSYLVANIA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

<p><b>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</b></p>	<p><b>Renewal cycle:</b> <a href="#">Biennial - Renew by December 31 of even-numbered years</a></p> <p><b>Minimum CMEs:</b> <a href="#">100 CME every two years – Minimum of 20 Category 1</a></p> <p><b>State-mandated CME content</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">2 Board-Approved Child Abuse Recognition/Reporting</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">2 Pain Management/Addiction/Prescribing</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">12 Patient Safety/Risk Management</a></li> </ul>
<p><b>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</b></p>	<p>Two (2) hours of Board-approved continuing education in child abuse recognition and reporting requirements must be completed for renewal or reactivation of a license.</p> <p>All prescribers or dispensers must complete at least two hours of continuing education in pain management, the identification of addiction or in the practices of prescribing or dispensing of opioids.</p> <p>At least 12 of the 100 hours must be completed in activities related to patient safety or risk management and may be completed in either Category 1 or 2.</p>
